

Moravian Academy Green Pond Day Camp 2008

Green Pond Day Camp meets daily, Monday – Friday, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., for five weeks from June 16 to July 18, 2008 for children from infant to those entering grade 7. The camp will be run as five independent one week sessions. You may sign your child up for any or all of the weeks that fit into your summer schedule. Each week revolves around a central theme and all of the children's activities – arts and crafts, drama, music and field trips – focus on the theme.

Transportation will not be provided to and from camp.

Campers also take part in sports and swimming. Certified life guards are on duty during all swimming activities. All children are tested on their swimming abilities.

The dates for the five weeks in 2008 are:

Week 1 – June 16 - June 20

Week 2 – June 23 - June 27

Week 3 – June 30 – July 3 (no camp on July 4)

Week 4 – July 7 – July 11

Week 5 – July 14 – July 18

Campers are grouped by age or grade level:

Little Lions for Infants to age 3

Spot for Tots for children ages 4 & 5

Juniors for students entering grades 1 & 2

Seniors for students entering grades 3 & 4

Middlers for students entering grades 5, 6 & 7.

The Directors of the individual Day Camps are all experienced teachers. Our counselors are teachers and college students. Little Lions will be led by Gina Hinkle, owner and director of the Music Together program in the Lehigh Valley, and former Green Pond Day Camp counselor. Green Pond's Spot for Tots is directed by Miss Robyn Endress, a first grade teacher at Moravian Academy and director of Spot for Tots for 24 years. The Junior and Middler Camps will be directed by Jason Hinkle, a fourth grade teacher in the Easton Area School District. Mr. Hinkle served as the director of the Middler and Junior Camp last summer. The Senior camp is directed by Ms. Diane Taylor, a second grade teacher at Moravian Academy for over 20 years.

Camps are located on the Merle-Smith Campus, 4313 Green Pond Rd., Bethlehem, PA 18020

Before-and after-camp care is available.

The Before-Camp and After-Camp Care Program provides a nurturing, safe environment for our Day Campers. Children participate in a variety of activities which include arts and crafts, swimming, games and outdoor play.

Before-Camp Care begins each camp morning at 7:30 a.m. and runs until the start of the Day Camp Program at 9:00 a.m.

After-Camp Care is offered from 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.

Both sessions are offered Monday through Friday to children already registered for any of the Day Camp Programs. There is a \$4.95 per hour charge.

It is imperative that children not be dropped off before 7:30 a.m. and that they be picked up by 5:30 p.m. There is a \$50 late fee for pickups after 5:30 p.m. There is no supervision prior to 7:30 a.m.

Children can be dropped off and picked up at Walter Hall on the Merle-Smith Campus.

Advanced registration of children is required and should be indicated on the Day Camp registration form.

Ms. Susan Ender, a teacher in the Extended Care program at Moravian Academy's Lower School, will be Green Pond Day Camp's Director of Extended Care, assisted by Ms. Alex Mindler. Both Ms. Ender and Ms. Mindler have worked at Green Pond Day Camp for many years.



LITTLE LIONS
Ages infant to 3

A camp for our littlest campers and a CAREGIVER! Little Lions will be run as an organized playgroup with games, water activities and lots of time to run around in the sunshine!

Each Little Lion must be accompanied by a responsible ADULT (must be 18 years or older, but does not have to be a parent) who will remain with the camper for the entire morning of camp.

If your youngest doesn't want to leave when you drop off an older sibling at camp, this is a great opportunity to let him or her experience camp, too. Little Lions will also offer a good transition when your camper is ready for Spot for Tots.

We will meet twice a week, on TUESDAY AND THURSDAY mornings, from 9:00 am to 12:00 noon. Snacks, sports equipment, art supplies and activities will be provided each session. Listed below are the dates and theme for each week.

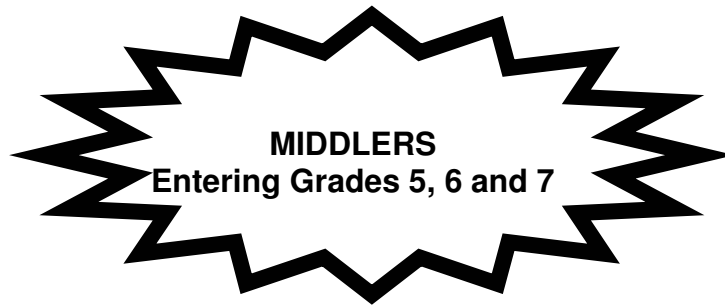

- Fill out the appropriate registration form. **Please use one registration form per child.** Copy the form as many times as necessary. You may request additional forms from the summer programs office or print out forms from our website: www.moravianacademy.org
- A registration fee of \$50.00 for each week is required in order to enroll. This deposit is not refundable and will be credited toward the overall week's fee.
- There is a \$30 discount (\$15 discount for Little Lions) if you sign up in advance for ALL 5 weeks of camp. If you register for 5 weeks and cancel 1 or more weeks, you will be charged \$160/week for those weeks your child attends camp (plus the \$50 non-refundable deposit for each week of camp cancelled).
- **The balance for each DAY CAMP WEEK IS DUE May 1. Full payment for camp is due before your child can participate in the program.**
- For Before and After-Camp care, a fee of \$4.95 per hour is billed through the Moravian Academy Business Office per camp session. **It is imperative that children not be dropped off before 7:30 a.m. and that they be picked up by 5:30 p.m. There is a \$50 late fee for pick-ups after 5:30 p.m. There is no supervision prior to 7:30 a.m.**
- Early registration is recommended as there is a limit on the number of applicants accepted for each program. **If your registration is received after the program enrollment maximum has been reached, you will be notified and your child can be placed on a waiting list.**
- Refunds will not be made after May 1, 2008. Refunds before May 1 will be for the cost of the course minus the non-refundable registration fee.
- Your child is automatically enrolled unless notified otherwise. A copy of your registration form will be returned to you after processing by the Business Office. If you cannot be accommodated due to program limits and do not wish to be placed on a waiting list, your payment will be returned.
- Cost of materials, supplies, and a camp t-shirt is included in the fee.
